


# Community Safety Watch

Community Safety Watch connects communities with technology to stay safe, report & view local crime incidents and alert family members of emergencies with an alert button. Community Safety Watch is based on safety awareness and education in schools and communities and is a tool for crime prevention and in NO way are we promoting vigilante or unsafe behaviour.

Complete your profile details. Edit this screen and you will see there is an option to make your address details and photos visible if you wish. For privacy reasons we recommend you don't make these details visible unless necessary (an incident notification may require this).



Simply complete the two text fields and click submit. You can also add photos in your post.

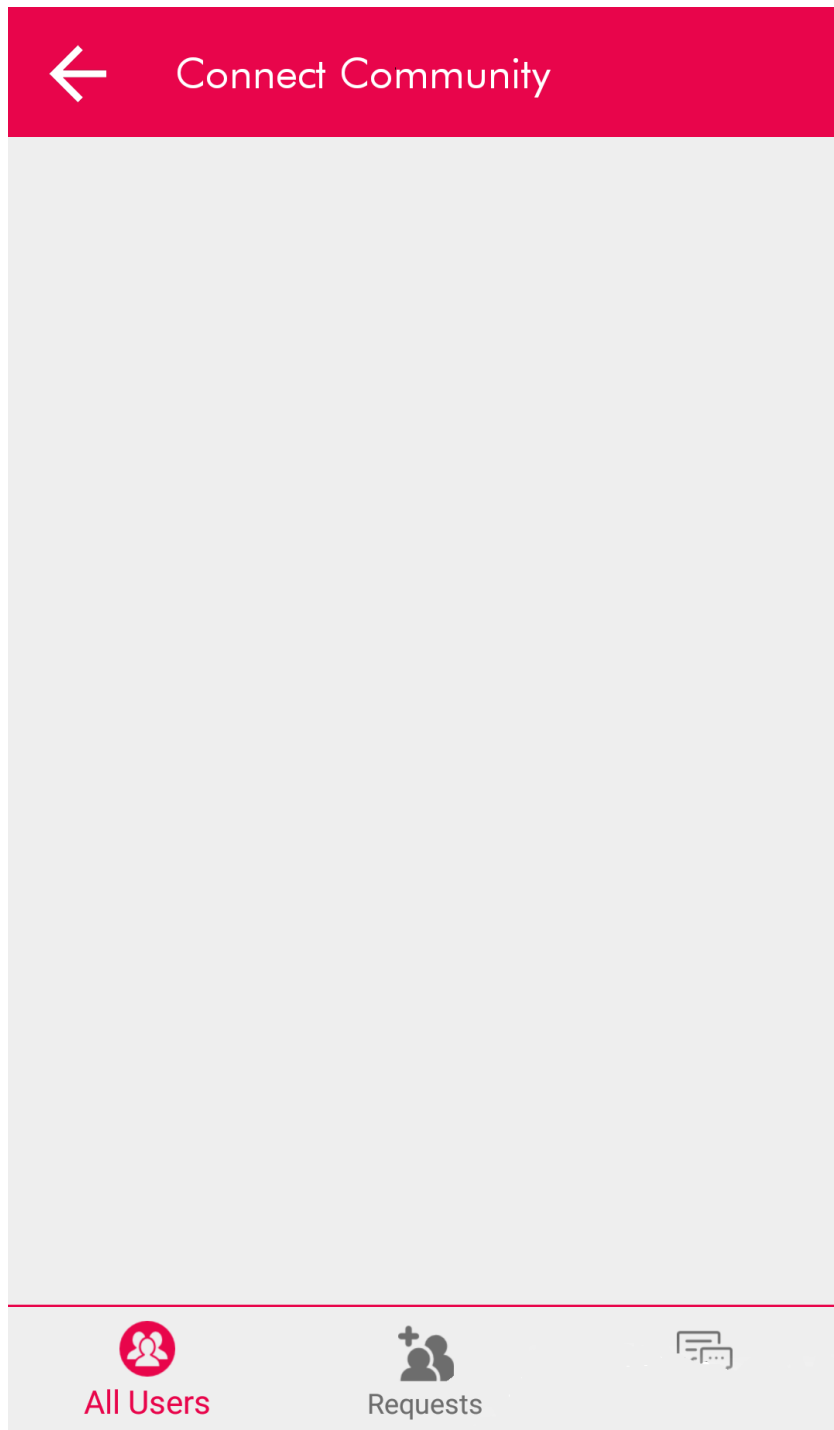

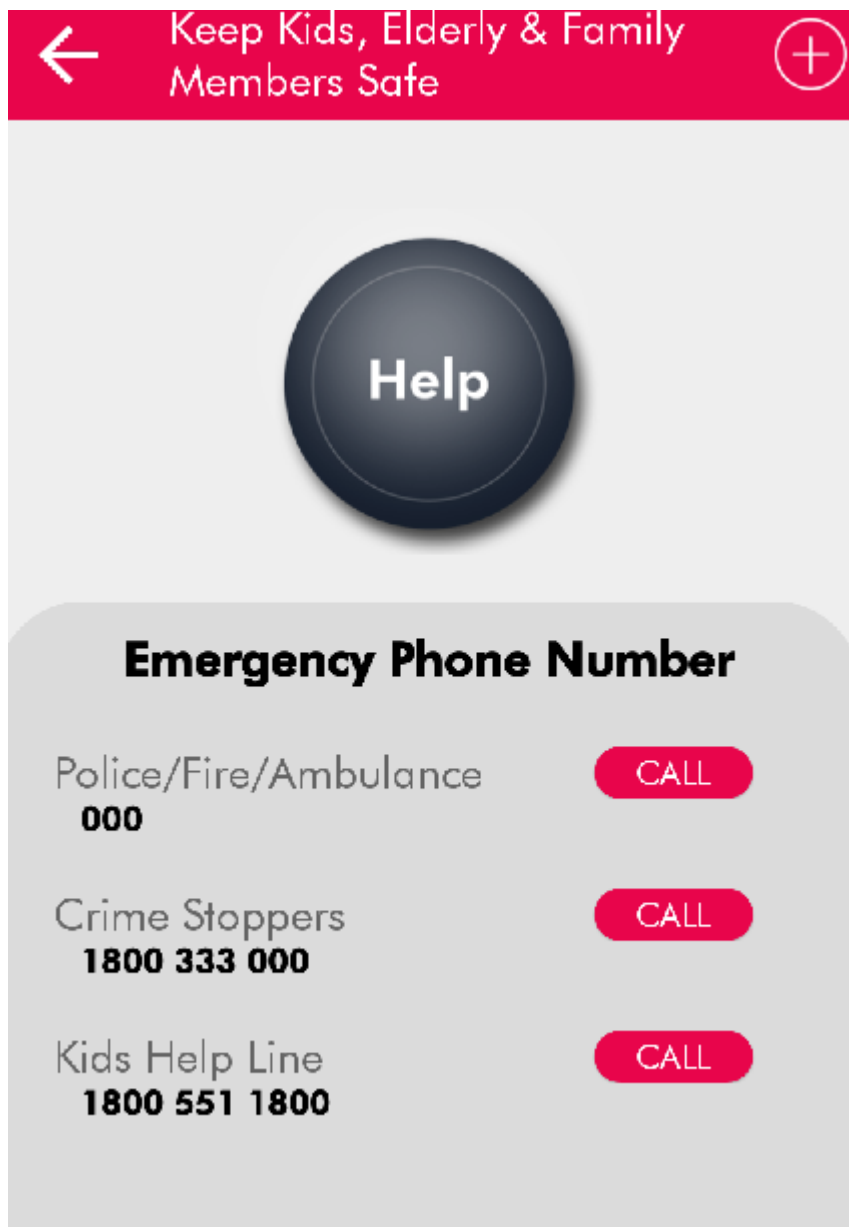


Click on Connect with your community to connect with other users in your area within a 20km radius. Any app users will appear and you can click “Connect” to request to connect with other users.

Icons appear at the bottom of the screen to show “All Users”, “Friend Requests” and “Chat Feeds”.



The personal alarm is an important feature of Community Safety Watch.





This alarm is used to keep family members safe that are facing an emergency situation. To use this feature, it is **IMPORTANT TO CLICK ON THE + SIGN AT THE TOP OF THE SCREEN TO ADD 2 EMERGENCY CONTACTS**

← Add Emergency Number

**Select which contacts will receive a text message in case of emergency.**

Enter First number +

Enter Second number +

CONFIRM

Enter two emergency contact **MOBILE** phone numbers and **CHECK THAT THE NUMBERS ARE CORRECT (PHONE NUMBERS MUST BE MOBILE NUMBERS SO THEY RECEIVE A TEXT MESSAGE IF YOU ACTIVATE THE ALARM)**. You can enter one mobile number but we suggest you enter two contact mobile numbers.

Once you are happy that the mobile phone numbers are correct, click the confirm button. PLEASE TEST the alarm to make sure the alarm works with the numbers you have inserted.

**Only use this alarm in case of an emergency.**

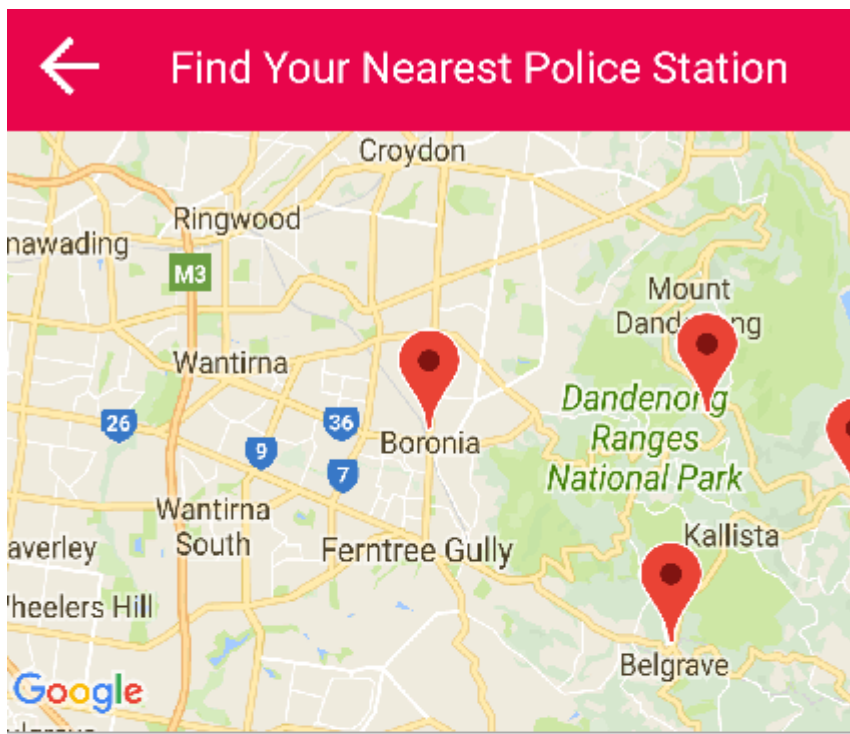
Once activated, the alarm will send a text message to your emergency contact with your exact address and a link to a map showing your geo location so you can be found at the click of a button.
