



Community Safety Watch Basic Safety Checklist

Residential Address

1. Is your street number clearly marked and visible from the street so emergency services can find you?
2. Do you have a family fire safety plan? Do you have a security safety plan?
3. Are you smoke alarms working and tested regularly?

Signs to deter thieves

4. Do you have a Community Safety Network sticker or other security sticker clearly located at your home as a deterrent?

Residential Boundary

5. Are fences in good condition and secure?

Lighting

6. Do you have external sensor lighting?
7. Do you have timers on your lighting?
8. Are entry and exit points clearly lit?
9. Can people see your home clearly from the street?

External Buildings

10. Are external buildings locked? (shed etc)
11. Ensure tools are locked away so as not to be used in the event of a potential burglary.

Doors & Locks

12. Are external doors and frames solid?
13. Is a peep hole installed?
14. Are quality locks fitted and working?
15. Remove keys from locks when not in use.
16. Is a security door installed?

Windows

17. Are windows and frames solid?
18. Are window locks fitted and working?

Property Identification

19. Have you recorded details of your household items for insurance? (photo & video, receipts)
20. Is your property engraved for easy identification?
21. Do you have adequate insurance?

Security Alarms

22. Is a security alarm/CCTV system & installed & tested?

23. Is the alarm system monitored?
